The Sacramento County Bar Association (SCBA) announces its sponsorship of a food drive “Food from the Bar” in conjunction with Sacramento Food Bank & Family Services. SCBA will join with Bar Associations throughout the nation in a food drive from April 19, 2010 to May 14, 2010. This is a great opportunity for members of the legal community to help those in the Sacramento community who need the most help. Food from the Bar is a grass-roots campaign started by lawyers to fight hunger among children in our communities. Law firms and legal offices participate by contributing money, donating food and volunteering time.

Food from the Bar originated with the Bar Association of San Francisco working with the San Francisco Food Bank in 1990. In 2009, the Los Angeles County Bar Association successfully launched its Food from the Bar food drive that brought together members of the legal community in raising money, donating food and contributing time to assist in the distribution of food to the needy.

Food from the Bar 2010 will make a difference for the children in the Sacramento community. Sacramento lawyers can do more than advocate for justice and equality. By supporting Food from the Bar, lawyers can provide a collective voice for ending hunger in Sacramento.
